

## National Wheat Yield Contest – Supervisor Checklist

### Eligibility Verification

- Supervisor is present at harvest
- Supervisor role is eligible (FFA Advisor, Vo Ag Instructor, County Agent, NRCS Employee, College of Ag Instructor, Accredited Farm Manager, Crop Consultant, Ag Banker, Crop Insurance Agent/Adjuster, Certified Crop Advisor, or retired from one of these roles)
- Supervisor is NOT an employee, relative of the contestant, or the contestant

### Supervisor Information

- Provided name to contestant
- Provided email address
- Provided phone number
- Provided role/title
- Confirmed information entered in Harvest section of Contestant Entry

### Field & Acreage Verification

- Contest field is at least 5 total acres
- Minimum of 1.5 acres harvested from the field
- Field consists of continuous acres of one seed entry
- Seeder width and row spacing are uniform
- Grass waterways/drainage ditches handled per contest rules
- Wheel tracks NOT subtracted from harvested plot calculations

### Seed & Variety Verification

- Variety verified
- Seed is newly purchased
- Proof of purchase reviewed and matches supervised plot

### Harvest Preparation

- Present for entire harvesting of contest plot
- Combine is empty before harvest
- Auger is empty before harvest
- Wagons/trucks are empty before harvest

### Field Measurements & Data Collection

- Heads counted per 3-foot row (average of 3 counts)
- All field measurements verified
- All computations overseen

### Harvest & Weighing

- Harvest witnessed
- Weighing witnessed
- Scale tickets initialed or signed
- Test weight included on scale ticket

### Moisture & Grain Sample

- Grain moisture tested on day of harvest
- Moisture recorded
- Minimum 10 lb grain sample obtained or overseen (will only be used if national winner)
- Contestant instructed to store grain sample safely

### Harvest Data Entry & Questions

- Contestant or advisor enters and submits harvest data by the **October 1 deadline**
